- 6. The Trustee will cease making the adequate protection payments as soon as the plan is confirmed or this case is dismissed or converted.
- 7. The Trustee shall have no liability for failure to make adequate protection payments based on the failure of the debtor(s) to make timely payments to the Trustee or into the Chapter 13 plan.
- 8. If a creditor, who is the subject of this order, objects to the adequate protection payments detailed in this order, the creditor(s) shall file an objection to this order with the US Bankruptcy in Akron, Ohio within 21 days of the date on this order.
- 9. Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. Section 102, if no party in interest requests a hearing on this agreed entry, the Chapter 13 Trustee is authorized and directed to make adequate protection payments to the creditor(s) as detailed in this order.
- 10. If a creditor, who is the subject of this order, signs the order, is shall be deemed an agreed order and the 21 day objection period shall be deemed waived. Upon approval of this order by the Court, the Trustee is authorized to disburse funds as instructed in this order.
